HEADS

How to operate Seacocks & holding tanks *Only bodily waste goes down* All the rest is garbage Etiquette (if on shore, use these)

GARBAGE

Nothing goes in the sea Discarding offshore (3 NM limit) Keep volume at a minimum

ON DECK

Boom: Gybing - Mainsheet Sails: How to handle / How to reef Roller furling (Main / Genoa) Winches & jammers : cautions Ropes - Use gloves Anchor: How to release

CREW WELFARE

Cold - Fatigue - Hunger - Fear Drink & eat regularly Stay warm and get some rest Collective chores Keep the boat tidy - mutual respect Any medical condition ? Watch system

SEASICKNESS

Don't be embarassed ! Get busy / inform the skipper Bucket or overboard (downwind) Banana's and medications (timely) Look after others (clip them on)
